

2014 Legislative Session Analysis: Virginia's Land & Water

The mission of VIRGINIA forever is to advocate for increased government funding for water quality improvements and land conservation across the Commonwealth. The 2014 General Assembly Session was like no other. Obstacles stemmed from a new governor and a General Assembly getting used to each other, as well as the governor carrying specific legislative goals that were high-profile and somewhat controversial. These factors all contributed to the historic budget standoff; never before has the debate over the budget in the General Assembly gone on for so long. To add to the delay, legislators recognized a last minute budget shortfall of \$1.0-\$1.5 billion.

Throughout the hectic session, VIRGINIA forever fought for specific goals:

- Water Quality to boost stormwater funding to \$50 million
- Land Conservation to seek an additional \$13.9 million, which is in keeping with the law

Here's how we fared:

Water Quality: Stormwater Local Assistance Fund (SLAF)

Land Conservation

Gov. McDonnell's proposal (introduced budget)

- Virginia Land Conservation Fund: \$2 M FY15 / \$2 M FY16
- Civil War Battlefields:
 \$1 M FY15 / \$1 M FY16
- Farmland Preservation: \$1 M FY15 / \$1M FY16

VF's Request

Per HB-1398 (2013) – add \$13.9 million in FY15

- Virginia Land Conservation Fund: \$11.1 M FY15 / \$0 FY16
- Civil War Battlefields: \$1.4 M FY15 / \$0 FY16
- Farmland Preservation: \$1.4 M FY15 / \$0 FY16

Outcome

- Virginia Land Conservation Fund:
 - \$1 M FY15 / \$1 M FY16
- Civil War Battlefields: \$1 M FY15 / \$1.4 M FY16
- Farmland Preservation: \$1 M FY15 / \$1M FY16
